Request for Individual Headphones/Headsets for each students Years 3 - 6

Bring your own Headphones/Headset (BYOH)

There has continually been an increase in the effectiveness in use of multimedia-enhanced content to enhance the quality of teaching and learning. This includes digital instructional materials that combine text, graphics, audio, and animations. At times, teachers and students use these to demonstrate and explain difficult concepts that cannot be easily explained using text alone. They can also help to improve students' understanding of instructional materials.

At Holy Cross we are very fortunate to have more than adequate amount of devices including chromebooks, laptops and iPads for our students to access to listen to new information as well as record and demonstrate their own learning to present to their peers and others. The use of these devices has increased with the project based and inquiry based learning.

In light of the benefits and in assisting the students in their learning and inquiry and project based learning the students would greatly benefit from being able to use "headsets". We believe that students would also benefit by having their own set. Therefore, we would like to request that in 2019 students in Years 3 - 6 bring in their own headphone/headset which can either remain at school in their tub or that the students bring their headsets to school each day. These do not need to be expensive and may be something they already own.

In 2019, Years 3 and 5 students will be completing NAPLAN online. Each student will require their own headphones for this test. If students are unable to bring in headphones the school will be able to provide this for them.
